

Housing Assistance Pilot Program

Sunshine Health was selected by the Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA) to participate in the SMMC Housing Assistance Pilot for Region 5 and Region 7.

This program helps our adult Medicaid members who are homeless or at risk of being homeless keep a stable living arrangement. Members must have a Serious Mental Illness or Substance Use Disorder diagnosis to qualify. The services provided to members in this program are in addition to their current Sunshine Health benefits.



Program Highlights
