

DESIGNATED ALTERNATE PRESCRIBING PRACTITIONER FORM

In accordance with NCQA Credentialing Standard CR3: Credentialing

Verification Element A2 – Valid DEA or CDS certificate, all practitioners without a valid DEA must have in place a designated alternate practitioner to write prescriptions on their behalf. This standard also applies to practitioners whose DEA certificate is pending.
