

Attestation of Total Patient Load

Dear Practitioner:

The Agency for Health Care Administration's regulations require an attestation for each group indicating that the total active patient load (all populations, including but not limited to Medicaid FFS, Children's Medical Services Network, SMMC plans, Medicare, KidCare, and commercial coverage) is no more than three-thousand (3,000) patients per Primary Care Practitioner (PCP).

An active patient is defined as one that is seen by the Primary Care Practitioner a minimum of three (3) times per year.

In order to meet contractual obligations, we ask that you provide the information requested below. Please check the box, sign and return this form with your credentialing or recredentialing documentation.

For a physician to have 3,000 active patients they would see in excess of 4 "active" patients every hour for 8 hours a day, 5 days a week, and 52 weeks of the year.

3,000 X 3 = 9,000 visits a year
9,000 / 52 = 173 visits per week
173 / 5 = 35 visits per day
35 / 8 = 4+ visits per hour
