HEDIS® MEASURE QUICK GUIDE

CONTROLLING HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE (CBP)

MEASURE DESCRIPTION

- **Ages:** 18–85 years
- **Goal:** 139/89 or less will close the care gap
 - If reading is 140/90 or higher, retake.
 - The last blood pressure reading of the year is used to determine BP control.
- **Eligibility Requirements:** Patients are included in the measure if they have had two or more visits with a diagnosis of hypertension during the measurement year.

Assess throughout the year to help the patient gain control through the following:

- Review diet and exercise efforts.
- Encourage your patient to use our BP Care Log for home readings.

- Assess medications and identify barriers for medication adherence.
- Determine if your patient would benefit from having a digital blood pressure monitor at home.
 - If so, refer them to SunshineHealth.com/OTC where they can use their \$50 monthly Over-the-Counter (OTC) Benefit to order one.

- Email SunshineCareCoordination@SunshineHealth.com for Case Management referrals for members with persistently uncontrolled hypertension. Include the member's Medicaid ID, date of birth, and the reason for the referral.

TIPS FOR READINGS

- **WHEN TAKING BLOOD PRESSURE:**

- Assure cuff is the correct size and fits properly on bare arm.
- Have patient sit with feet flat on floor and legs uncrossed.
- Support elbow at heart level during BP reading.
- Ask for patient's home BP reading taken on day of visit and record in medical record.

- **IF PATIENT'S BLOOD PRESSURE IS ELEVATED:**

Display the red heart door hanger to alert the treating provider. Reach out to your Provider Engagement Representative or Quality Advisor to receive one.

- Retake BP later in the visit.
- Record each BP reading taken during the visit or reported by the patient for the same date's home reading.
- Submit CPT coding for the lowest systolic and lowest diastolic blood pressure, including the home reading reported by the patient.
- Do not round-up blood pressure reading.
